To recommend appropriate and relevant capacity building programs for The different levels of researchers, research institutions and RHRDCs



# Proposed Framework for Assessing Health Research Capacity

March 2013

For the different evaluation components, the level of inputs, processes, outputs and outcomes will be measured, namely:

- Agenda Setting, Research Design and Implementation;
- Ethics;
- Capacity Building;
- Research Utilization,
- Resource Mobilization; and
- Structure, Organization, Monitoring and Evaluation

### Workshop on the Assessment Tools

A workshop was conducted to finalize the assessment tools prior pre-testing in the regions. The reviewed tools are as follows:

- 1. Research Institution Capacity Assessment Tool (RICAT)
- 2. Research Consortium Capacity Assessment Tool (RCCAT)
- 3. Researcher Evaluation Form (REF)

CBC agreed to pre-test the assessment tools in June, 2013.

Tapping of external consultant for the Roll out of the Assessment Tools

Early 2014

- Development of Terms of Reference (TOR) contracting Dr. Jesus N. Sarol, Jr. of National Teachers Training Center for Health Professions, University of the Philippines Manila (UP-NTTCHP) to roll-out the assessment tools
- The research capacity assessment in seventeen (17) regions was approved for implementation for the period, June 2014 - June 2015.
