Philippine Health Research Registry (PHRR)

What is the Philippine Health Research Registry (PHRR)?

- **It is a publicly-available database of newly-approved health researches (clinical and non-clinical trials)**
- **As a transition, ongoing projects as of 2012 are included**

What is the Philippine Health Research Registry (PHRR)?

- It is compliant with the World Health Organization (WHO) standard for clinical trials registry
- Uses an opensource software "Joomla" which follows the industry standards in creating a content management system
- Housed at PCHRD and may be accessed at

Objectives of PHRR

- **To track what kind of researches are going on**
- **To know who funds what kind of project**
- **To avoid duplication of researches**

FDA Circular 2012-007

- **Mandates that all clinical trials approved from July 15, 2012- onwards be registered within 30 days after the application to conduct the clinical trial has been granted**

PHRR Account

TYPES OF ACCOUNT

- 1. Registry officer account – administrator account**
- 2. Researcher account - individual researcher account - one institution may have several accounts for its researchers**

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
Registered Researches (clinical and non-clinical trials) as of July '13

Inquiries and Concerns

Project leaders don't have the time and staff due to the limited budget.

Actions by PCHRD

Uploading research info is a grant requirement. For data fields project leaders can just cut and paste from their project documents.

Inquiries and Concerns of Uploaders

Inquiries and Concerns

Project leaders don't want to disclose information regarding their research.

Actions by PCHRD

Information required for registry will not result to infringement of their intellectual properties.

Inquiries and Concerns of Uploaders

Investigators asked if access can be granted to people with no local address.

Actions by PCHRD

Philippine FDA requires a local person (a person based in the Philippines) to be responsible for all information uploaded in the registry.

Can we register in behalf of the sponsors such as the case of the CROs (Contract Research Organization).
