- Publication of research: requirement for tenure in some HEIs
- No uniformity in the practice of peer review and/or refereeing

huge variance in the quality of journals of research

Research & publication, a University function

PURPOSE

Prescribe a mechanism

National standard for peer review and journal refereeing system

Implemented uniformly by HEIS and others



Accreditation Service

CHED: Journal Accreditation Service

Journals recognized as peer reviewed/refereed journals

CHED Journal Codes: compliance to nationally accepted standards



IV. Overall Appearance, Timeliness and 30% Regularity of the Journal

Editorial Board Composition (30%)

- Editorial Board should be composed of:
 - Three (3) recognized research experts with two (2) or more major research papers published in a refereed journal in the last five (5) years
- Editors: research experts in the disciplines covered by the journal
- One (1) of the editors has published an original research article in an internationally indexed journal

Refereeing System (40%)

• Editorial Policies

Refereeing system or external review policy
 Policy for acceptance or rejection of a research manuscript

Manuscript

 Peer-reviewed by 2 referees who are experts on the subject

Editors

 Transmit reviewers' comments to authors

Revised Manuscripts

 Evaluated through Editorial Board for compliance

The Journal (20%)

Editing Process

- No grammatical errors
- No factual errors

Printed articles

- Citations
- References
- Bibliography appropriate and consistent format

Appearance

- Acceptable
- Standard elements of a reputable journal

Regularity and Timeliness (10%)

Incentives for Accredited Journals

CATEGORY	INCENTIVES
A	 For faculty members evaluated in compliance to publication requirements per CHED CMOs, publication in the journal is credited as an international level publication; CHED Journal Accreditation Award in the amount of P200,000.00 per year for 3 years. CHED endorsement for library subscription
B	 For faculty members evaluated in compliance to publication requirements per CHED CMOs, publication in the journal is credited as an international level publication;



- Journals accredited under Category B given until 2015 to qualify under Category A. Category B eventually phased-out.
- New applications for CHED accreditation until December 2012.
- CHED accredited journals to become Category A-1 (ISI/SCOPUS).
