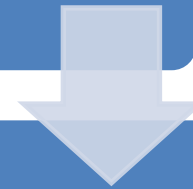

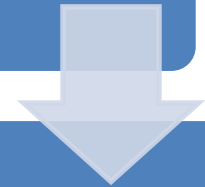

Criteria for Evaluation

| IV. Overall Appearance, Timeliness and Regularity of the Journal | 30% |

Editorial Board Composition (30%)

- Editorial Board should be composed of:
Three (3) recognized research experts with two (2) or more major research papers published in a refereed journal in the last five (5) years
- Editors: research experts in the disciplines covered by the journal
- One (1) of the editors has published an original research article in an internationally indexed journal

Refereeing System (40%)

- Editorial Policies

- ➔ Refereeing system or external review policy

- ➔ Policy for acceptance or rejection of a research manuscript





The Journal (20%)

Editing Process

- No grammatical errors
- No factual errors

Printed articles

- Citations
- References
- Bibliography appropriate and consistent format

Appearance

- Acceptable
- Standard elements of a reputable journal

Upgrading of Category B to A by 2015

- Journals accredited under Category B given until 2015 to qualify under Category A. Category B eventually phased-out.
- New applications for CHED accreditation until December 2012.
- CHED accredited journals to become Category A-1 (ISI/SCOPUS).

27 accredited or 22%
